CERTIFICATION ROAD MAP

The APICS Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP) is a professional development and certification program that brings the entire value chain into perspective by providing a truly end-to-end view of the global supply chain. Follow these steps and you are on your way to advancing your supply chain management career with the premier APICS CSCP designation.



1 Find out if the APICS CSCP program meets your education and training needs. Visit www.apics.org/cscp.

2 Determine if you are eligible for the APICS CSCP certification exam.

You must fulfill **ONE** of the following [APICS CSCP exam eligibility requirements](#):

- 5 years of related business experience, OR
- APICS CPIM, APICS CFPIM, APICS CIRM, C.P.M. and two years of related business experience, OR
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent and two years of related business experience.

3 Use the APICS CSCP Learning System to prepare for the certification exam.

4 Choose your learning experience and complete the APICS CSCP Learning System.
