- Perform statistical analysis and apply forecasting techniques for the enhancement of performance forecast models.
- Work with product development, sales, and marketing to forecast new products.
- Determine and maintain proper inventory targets and adjust inventory target to be efficient while meeting fill-rate needs across all warehouses.
- Analyze and report on various inventory metrics as well as customer service metrics.
- Track and analyze inventory days on hand, target inventory levels and lead time variability etc.
- Work as a cross functional team member to identify slow moving and obsolete inventories.
