PRODUCTION DEMAND PLANNER – Wall Township Facility

This position is accountable for the development and implementation of an effective planning, forecasting, and allocation strategy to support the company's business objectives. Primarily responsible for the production planning of approximately 4,000 items, including finished goods. Maintain a dynamic demand profile and production plan through monthly forecasting techniques utilizing SOP, forecast transfers and daily MRP runs. Communicates with various functional leaders to ensure a smooth and efficient operation to deliver products to primary locations. Performs related duties as assigned.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Monitor and report in advance on any forecasts or customer orders that cannot be met.
2. Conducts the monthly build plan and capacity review.
3. Coordinates and performs the applicable M3 transactions associated with the sequence of assembly, and movement of parts through multiple manufacturing operations for conversions or expired materials.
4. Determine the feasibility of committing to expedited jobs that could delay or alter existing schedules.
5. Prepare production reports as requested by management.
6. Analyzes and interprets bills of materials as needed.
7. Determines the scope of rework involved for unforeseen circumstances that may disrupt regular production operations. I.e.: internal or external quality issues.
8. Monitors, analyzes and reports departmental and company performance as it is related to established schedules utilizing information derived from M3 and the Company Hyperion Master Dashboard.
9. Ensures all parties are fully cognizant of production status and that work planning and execution objectives are integrated and communicated.
10. Interfaces with Supply Chain, Engineering and OEM Sales to expedite and coordinate the delivery, or release to production of p/n's not released in M3 in order to support committed schedules.
11. Initiates manufacturing replacement orders for lost, damaged or discrepant items.
12. Supports MRB Team with M3 Scrap transactions to ensure we are properly generating the correct replacement actions for items quarantined for review.
13. Resolves problems as needed utilizing acquired knowledge and analytical skills.
14. Review impact level load support departments utilizing CPS 100:
 - a. Cutting
 - b. Sewing
 - c. Mechanical Assembly
 - d. Bench Assembly
 - e. Inflatons
15. Review requests for conversions of existing product in stock.
16. Review availability of parts and labor for engineering demand.
17. Other duties and projects as assigned

Job Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from a four-year college or university in a related field. 4-7 years of forecasting, demand planning or sales analysis experience; exceptional analytical skills, strategic thinker and ability to read and identify business trends.
- Must either be certified in APICS or pursuing certification or be willing to obtain certification.
- Ability to read, analyze and interpret general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedure or governmental regulations.
- Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups of managers, clients, and customers.
